Grand Continent Hotels doubles down on budget segment growth; eyes aggressive India expansion

Bengaluru-based Grand Continent Hotels Ltd., a SME-listed hospitality chain with a portfolio of 30 operating hotels, forayed into Gurugram in Delhi NCR with a 38-room business hotel in Sector 45, with a second property signed already in Sector 15. Ramesh Shiva, founder & MD of the company spoke about the vision of the group.

Although Grand Continent Hotels opened a flagship Luxury Collection, an entry-level 5-star hotel, in October 2025 in Udaipur, marking its foray into the Northern Indian hospitality market—for Ramesh Shiva, the founder and MD of the

group, the boutique 38-room Gurugram property opened on March 29, 2026, at Green Wood City, Sector 45, was far more significant considering it aligns with their “core strength” and gives far higher potential in “cross-selling” to their corporate customers from IT hubs like Bengaluru, Hyderabad, Chennai. The Gurugram property is their 30th opening.

As an icing on the cake, the hotel group has also signed its second property, a 58-room mid-market hotel, in the same city, on Sector 15, on the sidelines of the opening of the first property. “We have 10 more properties signed and opening in FY 2026, adding another 750 rooms to our inventory,” said Shiva.

Established in 2011, the hotel company operates hotels in three differentiated segments - Grand Continent Hotels & Resorts (3-star), Grand Continent Premier Collection (4-star), and Grand Continent Luxury Collection (entry level 5-star).

“The strength of Grand Continent is more on the basic three-star category hotels... our exploration will be more into budget segment hotels,” he said, adding that the average room rent in this category ranges between Rs 4,000 and Rs 5,000.

After Gurugram, the Grand Continent Hotels will be expanding into important pilgrim cities in the North like Varanasi, Ayodhya this year, he said. The upcoming properties are spread across key business and pilgrimage destinations, Siva said. These include Jaipur, Bengaluru (two new properties at Devanahalli), Somnath, Rameshwaram.

Although the hotel company has expanded internationally to the US recently, with three hotels in cities like Missouri, Nebraska and Iowa, Siva felt that “the business is much better in India” and would like to focus on this market more than any other geography. It also operates a franchise hotel in Dubai.

It also operates a franchise hotel in Dubai.

“We are lined up with a lot of hotels in India... our core strength will be only in India,” Siva emphasised, adding that the domestic market offers stronger and more reliable growth opportunities.

The company typically targets properties with 50–80 rooms, aligning with its operational expertise in the budget and mid-market segment. “Minimum is 50 to 80 rooms, that’s our strength,” he said.

Grand Continent operates largely on a lease model, wherein property owners invest in infrastructure while the company manages operations, staffing, and P&L.

“We take the entire responsibility of operating the hotel. The owner just leases out the property,” Siva explained. This model, coupled with standardised service and professional management, has helped the brand differentiate itself in a fragmented budget hotel market.

Highlighting its value proposition, he added: “What we offer at Rs 4,000, you will not get this type of standard of rooms or service in any other part.”

Looking ahead, Grand Continent aims to scale up to 45–50 hotels with 3,000–3,500 rooms by FY2028, positioning itself for a transition from SME listing to the main board.

Siva also expressed confidence in the resilience of India’s domestic travel demand, particularly in the budget segment, even amid global uncertainties.

“India should be proud. We are not dependent on any foreign market for business. We are still maintaining an occupancy of 70–75 per cent,” he said, noting that the company’s room-driven revenue model insulates it from volatility amidst geopolitical crises, especially the crisis in West Asia.

With strong domestic demand, an asset-light model, and a clear focus on value-driven offerings, Grand Continent Hotels is betting big on India’s growing appetite for quality budget accommodation.

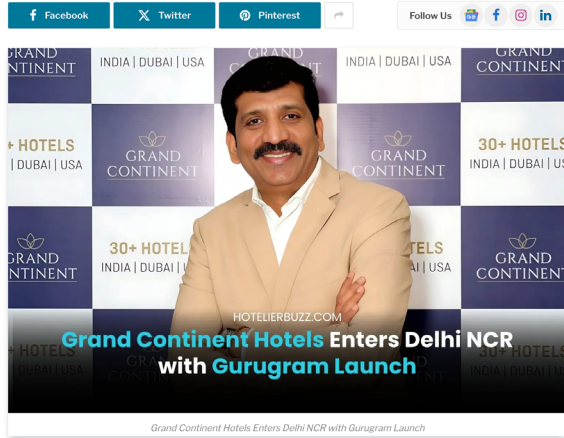

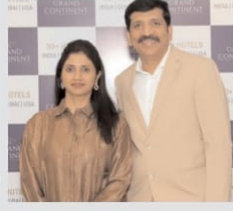
